



Scuba Diving with Tornado

Guests travelling on a Whitsunday Rent A Yacht Bareboat have the opportunity to do an Introductory or a Certified Scuba Dive while sailing around the Whitsunday Islands.

The Scuba Dive Device is offered by 'Tornado Dive' which is a rendezvous service.

The dive will take place in the general area of North Hook Island or Blue Pearl Bay off Hayman Island or the Langford Reef Area.

These locations offer amazing fish life and the soft coral reefs grow right from the edge of the islands.

For Introductory Divers the process will take around 90 minutes from when the guests arrive at Tornado Dive. The process includes a Health and Dive Medical questionnaire, followed by a safety and information brief from a member of the Dive Team. Then it's time to kit up, do practice on the purpose built Dive Platform and finally enjoy a 25 to 30 minute fully guided Scuba Dive.

Certified Divers must present a valid Dive Card, have a short briefing with a member of dive team, kit up and then enjoy a guided dive for at least 30 minutes.

Please note: Tuesday is our maintenance and servicing day so Diving is not available. Guests with some Medical Conditions may not be able to Dive. If unsure, seek further advice before booking.

Dives cost \$70 per dive.

To Dive:

1. Pre-order a wetsuit from Whitsunday Rent A Yacht on their Equipment Hire Form.
2. While on your bareboat charter pre book the dive by contacting Tornado on VHF Channel 82 or 81, call vessel "Skybird, Skybird, Skybird" to arrange dive or phone Tornado Operations on 0488 047 016.
3. Meet up with Tornado at the designated time and location.
